Once again Roly Jones, Marc Rapson, PJ Phillips, John Miller and myself played a concert in Estoril, Portugal - The venue was The Casino...A vast space, which is not only a casino but also an entertainment venue, which can hold an audience of two thousand.

After flying from Stansted, on the afternoon of May 9th, we were met at Lisbon airport by my friend, promoter Emanuel, who was accompanied by friends and family. After throwing our bags and guitars into the truck, Emanuel headed to a restaurant where we were met by his family and most of his friends. Emanuel lives life to the full, so, as usual, there was a wonderful spread of food and wine. Around about midnight we checked in to the Hotel Amazonia...it had been a long day and crashed out in bed.

The next morning at breakfast I met Ian Street and his wife Karen (who live in Portugal). We decided to take a walk along by the sea - the weather was stunning and as we walked, Ian mentioned another mutual friend who had flown in from Switzerland to Estoril to see the show. Back to early autumn, 1963 - The Roulettes

With the 'beat' explosion and the Adam Faith resurgence, it was thought a good idea to do a 'Package Tour'...with some of the new chart stars, like Brian Poole and The Tremeloes, who were from London, and were also in the Charts with 'Twist and Shout' and Do You Love - Me? Dave Berry and The Cruisers, the Sheffield group who were becoming popular after releasing My Baby Left Me, a cover of the Arthur Crudup song that had been a hit for Elvis in the fifties. Also on the tour, two Liverpool groups, The Searchers and The Undertakers. The Searchers were one of the biggest Merseyside groups, along with The Beatles and Gerry and The Pacemakers.

It would be my first package tour. I'd heard about them from John Rogers, who had toured with Dave Sampson and The Hunters on a Cliff Richard and The Shadows tour. John told of the hours of boredom on the tour bus, travelling hundreds of miles from town to town, and how they found of ways of alleviating the tedium, by throwing things at pedestrians...sometimes it would be small bags of flour, or if you were on of the lucky people on the pavement you would have coins hitting you on the back. Apparently it was amusing to see people scrambling for the small coins rattling on the curb stones. To be continued....



Many are probably unaware that two albums later, Elkie recorded three more Russ Ballard songs, one of which features as this month's Cover Quest song.

#### Three Wishes by Elkie Brooks

**Inspiration**, the 1989 album by **Elkie Brooks**, is a mixture of cover versions and original tracks and was recorded at Abbey Road Studios, RPM Studios, Pavilion Studios, Rock House and Woody Bay Studios. The album was issued on CD, vinyl and cassette in 1989 through Telstar Records, and re-released by Ronco in 1993. Russ produced all three of his songs and here is one of them, **Three Wishes**. Instantly recognisable as Russ, I think.
