A few weeks ago, I was asked by Frontiers if I would play some songs at their annual Summit meeting to be held at the Gold Tower Hotel in Naples on 3rd March. I liked the sound of that, so I did agree to play five, unplugged songs from my new double albums - 'Songs from Warehouse' & 'Rewired'.

I must say, The Gold Tower was the perfect venue and Frontiers, the perfect people to host the event.

Playing unplugged isn't something I'm used to, so I had to modify the arrangement of my songs. Strumming the guitar is not my usual style, however I found going out of my comfort zone was a buzz. Apart from kicking the p.a. System monitor off the stage in a kick of enthusiastic choreography, while singing

New York Groove (the audience appeared to like it) 😂. When I arrived home, I thought maybe I should challenge my comfort zone more often.

RUSS - LIFE STORIES

This is summer 1966 - France, May to September - Backing Richard Anthony....

.....So, here we were [The Roulettes] going alone after backing Adam Faith from 1963 - 1966. Adam was taking a lot of time off from singing, which meant we, as his backing band were not earning. As luck would have it, music managers John Barker and Anne Niven offered us plenty of work....one of the projects was a tv series, backing singers, English and French stars.....Marianne Faithful, Mark Wynter and Lulu among others. The only French Artist I remember was Richard Anthony - One of the songs he decided to include was the Unit Four Plus Two number one, 'Concrete and Clay'....As it happens, Bob Henrit and I were the 'Plus Two' in that group.....We'd moonlighted from the Roulettes a couple of years before, to play as session musicians on that song. So after we'd recorded the song with Richard he was very happy with the result....so happy, he asked us if we would like to back him on a summer tour of France. Richard was a big star there and said he played regularly in the best venues, theatres and casinos. The tour would be from May to September and we'd be based in St. Tropez, which was close to where he lives in Gassin. He owned a Piper Aztec plane and we would be flying to the French Rivera venues, the Italian and Spanish concerts in that....Who could say no!!

This month features a singer who had his first big hit in 1968 as part of a duo called **The Marbles**. Their song **Only One Woman**, a **Bee Gees** composition, reached No.5 in the UK. He would go on to have further chart success in 1979 and 1980 with two classic **Rainbow** hits, before leaving to pursue other opportunities, which included joining the Michael Schenker Band, Alcatrazz and Impellitteri, before forming his own band.
